

The Role of PCC member

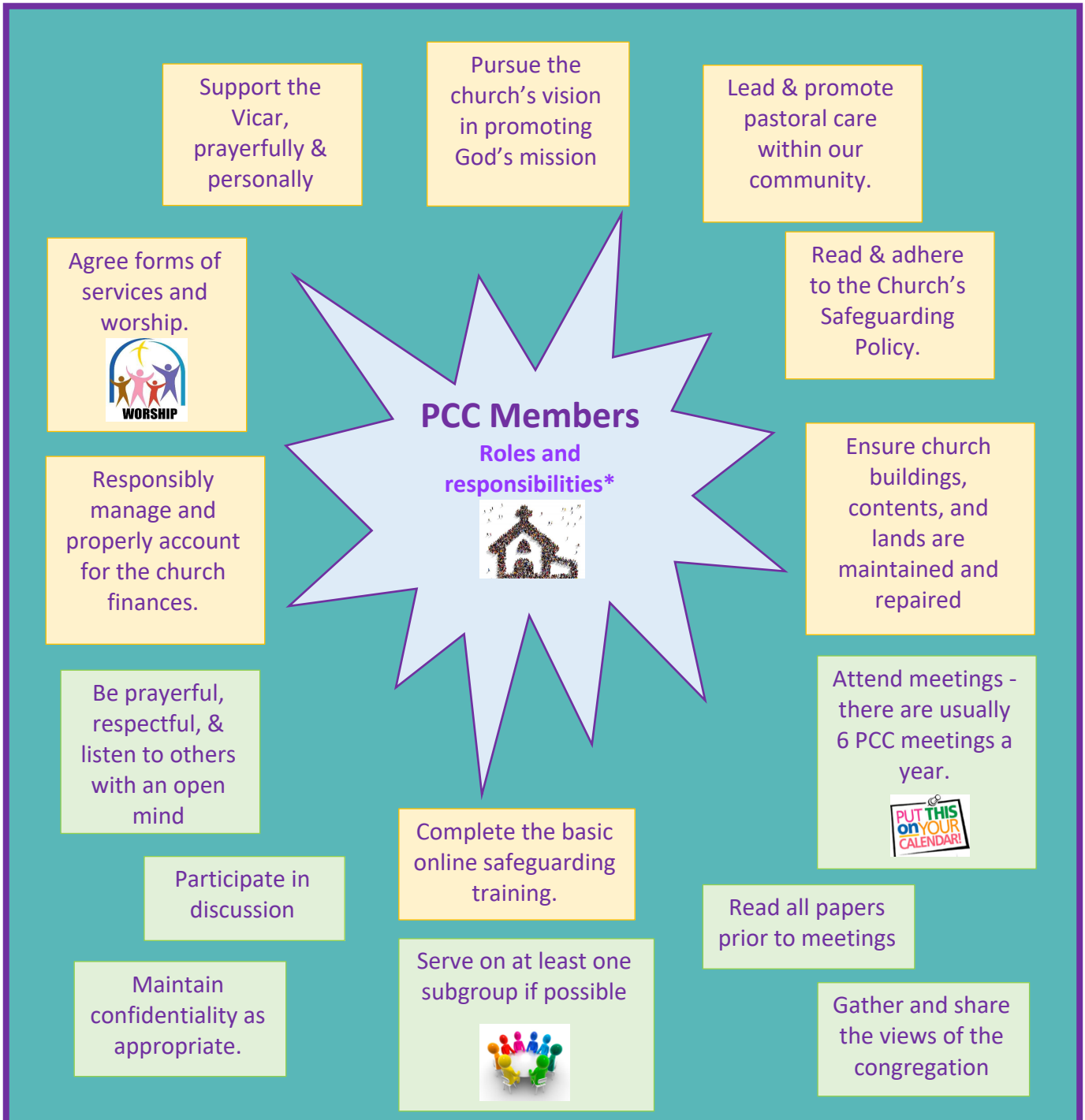


The PCC (Parochial Church Council) are the trustees of the church and the main decision makers of the parish. Its members are the church wardens and PCC members, who are elected at the Annual Parochial Church meeting, plus the vicar.



Criteria for becoming a PCC member; -

- Be over 16 years old and an actual communicant.
- To have been on the electoral role for at least three months before the election.
- Be nominated by two members of the congregation and consent to be appointed.



*Some responsibilities are delegated to the Church Wardens and Vicar, but the PCC should know about them. Please see Elaine Lockwood, the Church Wardens, or the Vicar for a more detailed Job description or if you are interested in becoming a member of the PCC. (The role requires a satisfactory DBS clearance & a self - declaration form.)
